

**MINERAL LAND SURRENDER FORM  
(SECTION 18 - MINERAL LAND TAX ACT)**

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, in right of the Province of British Columbia, as represented by the Minister of Energy and Mines,

(hereinafter called the "Grantee")

**OF THE SECOND PART**

WHEREAS the Grantor is the registered owner of mineral land as defined in the *Mineral Land Tax Act* (hereinafter called the "Act").

AND WHEREAS the Grantor is desirous of surrendering unto the Grantee all the Grantor's interest in the minerals as defined in the Act in the said mineral land.

NOW THEREFORE THIS SURRENDER WITNESSETH that the Grantor, in consideration of the premises, does hereby surrender, give up, renounce, yield up, release and quit claim unto the Grantee all of the Grantor's estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever both at law or in equity or otherwise howsoever and whether in possession or expentancy of him the said Grantor of, in, to the minerals within, upon or under the mineral land described on the schedule attached hereto.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the minerals unto and to the use of the Grantee, subject nevertheless to the reservations, exceptions, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original Grant thereof from the Crown.

WHEREVER the singular or the masculine is used in this Surrender, the same shall be deemed to include the plural or the feminine, or the body politic or corporate; also the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto and each of them (where the context or the parties so requires).
